

LA VAL CONDADO DE TEA 2023

The Rías Baixas recognises the Condado do Tea as appellation wines traditionally produced as blends that include Albariño, Treixadura and white Loureiro.

La Val Condado is a tribute to these ancient wines where diversity and complexity come together, full of mineral freshness.

The vineyard

The grapes come from the Porto estate (4Ha, planted 2010), with alluvial and pebble soils deposited where the Miño river used to flow. The pergola vine training system is the traditional Galician vine.

Winemaking

Separate fermentation of the three varieties. Spontaneous fermentation with the yeasts provided by the vineyard. Blending according to the characteristics of each variety depending on the vintage.

Vintage / Harvest description

The Treixadura and Loureiro grape varieties were harvested on the 6th of September with moderate alcohol content and high and perfect acidity. These varieties, are very sensitive to botrytis. Harvested in perfect health and with great quality prospects.

Tasting notes

Straw yellow with greenish reflections. Clean and bright. Good intensity on the nose with a marked fruity presence, apple, pear, citrus and an elegant and persistent floral background. Tremendously fresh, elegant and fruity at the same time, easy and pleasant on the palate, with citrus and saline nuances that invite you to drink.
